After School Tutoring

Location: Lyons Mill Elementary

Who is eligible: Students in grades 4 & 5 in danger of failing one or more subjects

Description: Students meet bi-weekly with LMES staff members to complete missing work and work on re-teach gaps in learning.

Math Homework Helpers

Who is eligible: All Baltimore County Elementary Students

Description: Short math lessons aligned with Home Connections specific to each grade level for students in Kindergarten through Grade 5.
